

VENTED SUMP LID INSTALLATION GUIDE

FOR USE IN RADON MITIGATION PROCEDURES

- 1. Install Prinsco sump following standard installation procedures. Make sure that the lid is in place before final sump installation to maintain the dimensional integrity of the sump.
- 2. Remove lid from completed sump installation.
- 3. Remove tape backing from foam gasket coil (A) and install on sump lid stop flange (B).
- 4. Install sump pump with 1-1/2" discharge pipe.
- 5. Thread the power cord through the gasketed hole (E).
- 6. To reinstall lid onto sump, lubricate the pump discharge pipe and pipe gasket in hole (C). Slide 1-1/2" discharge pipe into hole (C), push down on lid until locking tabs of sump lid snap into place on the sump, providing a positive locked lid.
- 7. Pull the excess power cord through the gasketed hole (E).
- 8. Install 4" PVC vent pipe into vent pipe gasketed hole (D).
- 9. To adequately vent the drainage system, a powered fan should be installed on the vent pipe. This will provide negative pressure in the system and will assist in radon mitigation. **Contact the United States Environmental Protection Agency and/or state and local environmental agencies for more specific information on radon control.**
